# An Overview of Direct View LED Displays

#### Abstract

Direct View LEDs display technology has found widespread use as digital billboards and in various sports venues. But as the pixel pitch of these products approaches that of AMLCDs, remarkably there has been almost no documentation or other detailed information about this technology in the SID literature. This presentation will cover the basic construction and performance of DV LEDs, focusing on high resolution, indoor designs. There will also be a discussion of the market utilization for these displays as well as a glimpse at the future.

Pat Green is Manager of Advanced Programs in the R&D Group at Planar Systems in Beaverton, Oregon. For over 35 years he had been involved in the development of displays and display-related components in engineering and engineering management roles at Planar Systems and Tektronix.
